TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Minimum Stay: The minimum stay on week-ends is 2 nights (Friday and Saturday) and 3 nights on public holidays. A minimum of 4 people required when booking the Farmhouse, Camp Mountain View, Camp Granite or Camp 360 on a week-end and minimum 2 pax for all other campsites

Check-In/Out: STRICTLY FROM 14h00 Check IN and Check OUT: 10h00

Reception: All guests to sign in at Reception, including a compulsory indemnity form.

Rates: Are per person per night and are subject to change without prior notice.

Payment: A 50% deposit is required to secure the booking. The balance is due 30 days prior to arrival. Deposit to be paid via EFT and this should be done within **3 days of booking**. If payment is not made in this time frame, we reserve the right to cancel the booking.

Cancellation/Postponement Policy:

If cancelling 7 days before arrival, for feit 100% of the booking total.

If cancelling 14 days before arrival, forfeit 100% of the deposit.

If cancelling 21 days before arrival, forfeit 75% of the deposit.

If cancelling 30 days before arrival, forfeit 50% of the deposit

Campsite Amenities:

Camp Dik-Dik, Camp KykNet and Camp Granite have open-air bathrooms with flushing toilets and bucket showers and are more suited for the romantic and wild at heart.

Camp 360, Camp Mountain View, Camp Petite & Camp Acacia have showers with hot water made in a donkey and are more practical functional campsites.

Take note that none of the campsites have electricity so please charge up your appliances beforehand.

Water:

Our borehole farm water is safe to drink Please try to save water during your stay

Access:

Access to the farm is via gravel roads. While we often host guests travelling in sedan two-wheel drive cars, a high clearance vehicle is a must, to get to the campsites. After heavy rains, one can only access the farm with a 4×4

Kjosk:

We have wood, ice, cold drinks, a variety of dry goods and curios for sale at our Reception Kiosk

We have a credit card machine at our Kiosk

Birds & Wildflife:

Please do not leave food out for the birds or wildlife. This is interfering with nature and it could intice baboons into the campsite. We have never had any incidents with baboons to date and we would like to keep it that way

Off Road Driving:

Please respect our farm and do not drive off road, into the riverbeds or into the No Entry roads

Fires:

Please take care with fires and barbecues/braai's when it is windy, as the grass can be dry and will burn easily. Do not leave any fires unattended. All accommodation facilities are provided with a hot ash dustbin, please use them

Privacy:

We would like to protect the privacy of our campers.

We don't mind if you want to take a look at the other campsites, but please first check with Reception to ensure the campsites are not occupied

Drones:

Please request permission from management

Recycling:

We have provided dustbins for waste separation and food waste. Please use them and do not mix plastic and metal with the food waste

Generators:

Due to noise pollution, we do not allow campers to use a generator

Ancient Rock Art:

If you happen to come across any rock art, do not touch the painted areas, throw water onto the art or intefere with the art in any manner and do not pick up any artefacts lying around. These are natural heritage items and belong to the farm.
