Terms & Conditions

Cancellation/Postponement Policy:

If cancelling 7 days before arrival, forfeit 100% of the booking total.

If cancelling 14 days before arrival, forfeit 100% of the deposit.

If cancelling 21 days before arrival, forfeit 75% of the deposit.

If cancelling 30 days before arrival, forfeit 50% of the deposit

Rates: Are per person per night and are subject to change without prior notice.

Payment: A 50% deposit is required to secure the booking. The balance is due 7 days prior to arrival. Deposit to be paid via EFT and this should be done within 3 days of booking. If payment is not made in this time frame, we reserve the right to cancel the booking.

Capacity:

The Farmhouse can accommodate up to 8 adults and the Cottage can accommodate 2 adults and 2 small kids

Minimum Stay:

The minimum stay on week-ends is 2 nights (Friday and Saturday) and 3 nights on public holidays.
A minimum of 4 people required when booking the Farmhouse or Camp Granite on a week-end

Check-In/Out:

Check-in time: 14h00 Check-out time: 10h00

Reception:

All guests to sign in at Reception, including a compulsory indemnity form. Please note we do not have a credit card facility, so bring cash for any extras

Water:

Our borehole farm water is safe to drink. Please try to save water during your stay

Wood:

When available, wood is for sale at Reception

Farm Basin:

Our farm basin is an unfenced pool. Guests and their children use the pool strictly at their own risk. Young children, whether swimming or not, must therefore be supervised by at least one suitably capable adult at all times

Pets:

Regret no dogs are allowed

Access:

Access to the farm is via gravel roads. While we often host guests travelling in sedan two-wheel drive cars, a high clearance vehicle is a must, to get to the campsites. After heavy rains, one can only access the farm with a 4 x 4 vehicle

Scenic Farm Roads:

Please respect the speed limit of 20km/hour due to the possibility of children walking or cycling on the roads.
We do not want any accidents

Off Road Driving:

Please respect our farm and do not drive off road, into the riverbeds or into the No Entry roads

Linen:

We operate on solar power only and thus ironing of bed linen is not possible.
We do promise that the linen will be 100% farm fresh!

Appliances:

All units rely 100% on solar power and thus no heating appliances may be used (e.g. hairdryers/coffee machines) or e-bike chargers/sleep apnea machines/extra fridges

Smoking:

Absolutely NO SMOKING inside please

Fires:

Please take care with fires and barbecues/braai's when it is windy, as the grass can be dry and will burn easily. Do not leave any fires unattended. All campsites are provided with a hot ash dustbin, please use them

Drones:

While we do allow drone use from time to time we require that drone operators respect the privacy of guests on the farm.

If we receive complaints or observe continued misbehaviour in this respect we reserve the right to insist that drone use cease immediately

Parties:

Our guests come here to experience the tranquillity of the Erongo Mountains, so please do not play loud music or disturb the peace in any way. Should you be asked more than once to reduce noise, you will be asked to vacate the farm (no refund)

Generators:

Due to noise pollution, we do not allow campers to use a generator

Hunting and shooting:

No shooting/hunting is permitted
